How do I protect my PC during a thunderstorm?

The season of thunderstorms is upon us. You may know to unplug your major appliances from the electrical outlets (tv, stereo, computer, etc.), but did you know you should also unplug the telephone line from your modem/computer?

When your telephone rings there is normally a 70-130V AC voltage in the line. This is the voltage present during normal telephone operation. But the situation in a thunderstorm is different. Lightning hits the ground with millions of volts and thousands of amperes. Every wire in the ground or hanging in the air will notice this electricity. Even a near lightning strike can generate a surge pulse of thousands of volts through the telephone lines. If this can go to the electronics inside the telephone or modem, the electronics will destroy at the same moment.

Modems are more prone to lightning surges for two reasons: modems have more delicate microelectronics in them and modems are connected to computers, which are connected to main sources of electricity. For those reasons modem electronics are prone to be damaged by lightning surges.

Now is a great time for Spring cleaning

This brings to mind cleaning and sprucing up the yard. This is also a great time to think about perking up your PC.

Your PC can become sluggish and loaded down with spyware, cookies and other unnecessary or unwanted Internet files.
