October Internet Tip—Setting Browser "cookies"

Sometimes "cookies" make it easier for you to log-in to various web pages without re-typing/remembering your password. When you are no longer able to "log-in" it may be because your privacy settings in your browser have changed. This month, we will teach you how to allow "cookies" for specific web sites or domains.

www.kdsi.net uses session cookies to help our users log-in. If your browser doesn't allow you to save your password, your Privacy and Security Settings may be set too high to allow these cookies to work.

If you are using Internet Explorer:

Click on TOOLS, then INTERNET OPTIONS.

Select the PRIVACY Tab.

Now click on SITES (if you have SP2) or edit the EDIT button.

In the "address of Web site" field type in the name of the site you want to receive cookies from, "kdsi.net".

Now click all the OKs.

You will now be able to get KDS Internet Session Cookies and log into our Web Site and your Account resources without entering your password each time.
