Is Spyware Spying on You?

Installed on your computer without your consent, Spyware software monitors or controls your computer use.

It may be used to send you pop-up ads, redirect your computer to other Web sites, monitor your Internet surfing, or record keystrokes which, in turn, could lead to identity theft. All computer users should know the signs that spyware has been installed on their machines, and then take the appropriate steps to delete it.

Some signs may include:

- A barrage of pop-up ads.
- A sudden or repeated change in your computer's Internet home page.
- New and unexpected toolbars.
- Keys that don't work.
- Random error messages.

- Sluggish or downright slow performance.

If you think your computer might contain Spyware, experts advise that you take 3 steps:

1. Get an anti-spyware program from a vendor you trust.
2. Set it to scan on a regular basis - at least once a week - and every time you start your computer, if possible.
3. Delete any software programs the anti-spyware program detects that you don't want on your computer.
